

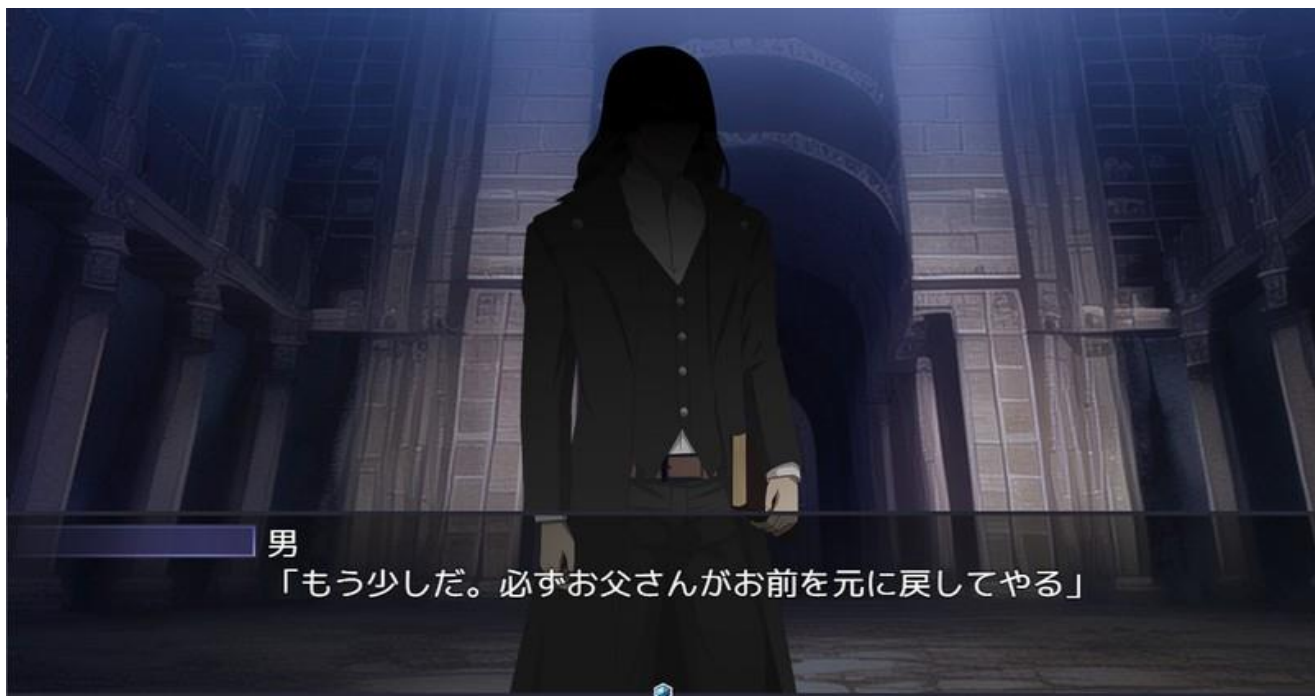
Chapter 3 Scene Premiere

However, Aster's expression changes dramatically when she sees who it is.



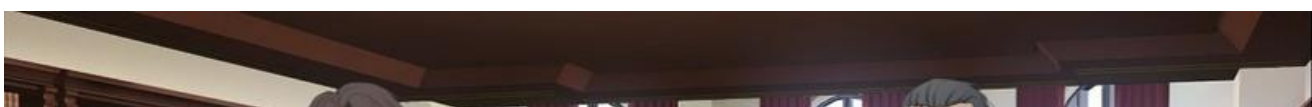
Ah.....
